# LEARN TO LIVE WITH SOROKIN

The world famous Russian and American scientist and sociologist. One of the founders of theories of social stratification and social mobility. One of the most prominent sociologists in the world survived political repression under the tsarist regime, two revolutions, a civil war and expulsion from the country. Unfortunately, the importance of the scientific works of Pitirim Sorokin was not appreciated either in Russia or in the USA. An exceptionally erudite sociologist wrote dozens of books and hundreds of articles, subsequently translated into forty-eight languages. His theories, revealing the problems and contradictions of human society, remain relevant in our days.

ValentinaAlexandrovna is a man of legend. Her name is associated with major studies, projects, of which she was the leader and immediate executor. V.A. Vityazeva belongs to the idea of developing the first General Scheme for the development and deployment of the productive forces of the Komi ASSR. Thanks to her, the proposal to transfer the northern rivers to the Caspian

basin was brilliantly defeated and suspended. She initiated the creation of the Timan-Pechora territorial production complex. This list of her scientific guesses and forecasts can be successfully continued. But the main idea, and then the brainchild of Valentina Aleksandrovna, of course, was the Syktyvkar State University fostered by her.

# MEDICAL INSTITUTE OF SSU

History of Medical Institute began with the creation of the Komi branch of the Kirov State Medical Academy in Syktyvkar on May 12, 1996.

Since 2003, teachers of the branch have been actively involved in medical, health, educational, and scientific advocacy work. Over the past years, clinical department staff have conducted more than 100 conferences, made more than 350 reports on scientific -practical conferences, the number of consultations amounted to more than 12000, the number of patients examined during rounds of the departments - more than 42000, the number of patients held by assistants - more than 8000, performed by the opera tions - more than 25,000 (of which a third were completed by full-time teachers). In addition, medical teachers participated in the consultations, KILI, LKK, appeared in the press and on television on scientific and medical topics, published in newspapers and magazines, etc.

The Institute has a modern material and technical base: lecture halls equipped with multimedia equipment, laboratories, anatomical hall and anatomical museum. A simulation laboratory has been created for practicing practical skills not only by students, but also by practicing doctors. The scientific and personnel potential of the Institute is highly qualified doctors and candidates of sciences, as well as practicing doctors.


# **ADMISSION PROCESS**

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR INDIAN STUDENTS:**

- Applicant has at least 50% marks in aggregate in Physics, Chemistry and Biology;
- Applicant should qualify NEET;
- Minimum age: 17 years till 31st December 2020;
- Applicant is not suffering from any contagious diseases i.e., tuberculosis, HIV AIDS etc.

# **ACCOMMODATION**

#### Hostels

There are two hostels for foreign students which have bathroom, toilet and kitchen. The hostels are centrally heated (air-conditioned). Hostels are fully furnished. The basic system is two or three students in one room. Students are provided with full beddings.

Separate arrangements for boys and girls. Every hostel is equipped with internet facilities (wi-fi and broadband).

Bed linen is changed once in a week and hostel is cleaned once everyday.

#### SECURITY

The hostels are reliable and quite safe for Indian students. All the necessary safety measures are taken care by the universities for the secure stay of the students. 24×7 CCTV surveillance, police security, wardens, and guards are there in hostel.

#### **INDIAN MESS**

Smolensk State Medical University provides a homely environment to the international students. An Indian Mess is available in the campus which serves high quality Indian food. There are around 20 people working in the mess including cooks, assistant cooks, waitresses etc. Two types of food is served in the Indian Mess:

- 1. Indian Pure Vegetarian
- 2. Indian Non-Vegetarian

The students are provided with two meals in the Indian mess every day that include lunch and dinner. High standards of Taste, Quality and Hygiene are maintained in the mess.







# STUDENT SUPPORT

#### STUDENT HUMAN RESOURCES:

The student personnel department is a structural unit of the University. The tasks of the department are:

- ensuring control over the observance of the rights, guarantees and benefits of students, defined by regulatory documents and local acts of the University;
- preparation and execution of contracts for the provision of paid educational services and additional agreements;
- the implementation of a unified policy in the field of social protection of the rights and legitimate interests of students, including or among orphans and children left without parental care, in need of social support;
- participation in the implementation of social programs for social protection and support of certain categories of students, the formation of an accessible environment for people with limited mobility.

#### **SWIMMING POOL:**

pool was built in 1972, the reconstruction lasted from 2010 to 2013. By design, the Pool is an artificial indoor structure sports facility, which includes one thicket 25x6 m., Showers, sauna, gym, inventory, medical and administrative premises.

The pool is used for swimming classes for students and employees of the SSU, has the appropriate equipment and inventory, the pool is also used to provide additional paid services to the population.

#### **SANATORIUM:**

Sanatorium was founded in February 1979 with the aim of conducting preventive, health-improving work with students, teachers, and university employees. Sanatorium is a multidisciplinary medical and prophylactic structural unit of SSU.



#### INDIAN STUDENTS ASSOCIATION

Every year the SSU Indian Students Association celebrates all Indian & South Asian festivals: e.g. Holi, Diwali, Durgapuja, Baishakhi, Eid.

In addition the Annual Cultural Festival is organized every year.

#### **MUSEUMS**

SSU consist of three museums, specialized museums of various profiles, created to increase the effectiveness of the educational, scientific and educational process, the basis for scientific research, the organization of thematic and art exhibitions, cultural and historical events, career guidance activities:

Museum of the History of Education of the Komi; The Museum of Archeology and Ethnography; The Zoological Educational Museum.

#### **BOTANICAL GARDEN**

The history of the Botanical Garden begins on June 13, 1974. This is a great place not only for long walks, but also for immersion in the world of botany and dendrology. The garden is an education center for beginner biologists, where theoretical and practical courses are held. The total garden area is 31.95 hectares.



# LIVING IN SYKTYVKAR

Syktyvkar is the capital and administrative center of the Komi Republic. The city is located in the northeast of the European part of Russia, 1,410 km northeast of Moscow. Syktyvkar is located on the banks of two rivers - Sysola and Vychegda.

#### SYKTYVKAR HISTORY

Syktyvkar history began in the 16th century when this area was settled by Komi. In 1780, by decree of Catherine II, Vologda viceroyalty consisting of nineteen counties was formed, among which was Ust-Sysolskiy county; thereby the village of Ust-Sysola was transformed into a county town of Ust-Sysolsk.

In the 19th century, Ust-Sysolsk turned into a large trade center in the North. At the beginning of the 20th century, it was a small provincial town with a population of about 6.5 thousand people, 95% of them were Komi.

#### SYKTYVKAR FEATURES

The population of Syktyvkar is about 243,000 (2015), the area – 152 sq. km. Syktyvkar is a large industrial center. The city has about 40 industrial enterprises, one third of which is of national importance.

In addition, Syktyvkar is one of the largest research centers in the European North of Russia. In the city, there are about 30 specialized institutions carrying out research and development work. The city is served by Syktyvkar Airport and Syktyvkar Southwest airfield. The city has a railway station as well.

Syktyvkar is the cultural capital of the republic. The largest state museum institution in the republic is the National Museum of the Komi Republic. The pride of Syktyvkar is the National Gallery of the Komi Republic.

The capital of Komi maintains friendly relations with foreign cities, five of which are twin cities of Syktyvkar: the city of Taiyuan (China, Shansi Province), the city of Los Altos (USA), the city of Culliera (Spain), the city of Debrecen (Hungary) and the city of Lovech (Bulgaria).
